## Acts 4:23

- ❖ John 6:67—"Do you want to go away as well?"
- John 6:68—"Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life, and we have believed, and have come to know, that you are the Holy One of God."
  - Galatians 6:2—Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

#### Acts 4:24a

John 18:36—"My kingdom is not of this world. If my kingdom were of this world, my servants would have been fighting, that I might not be delivered over to the Jews. But my kingdom is not from the world."
