February 21st was Bro Wayne Russell's 19th Anniversary serving as our Administrator/Minister of Education.

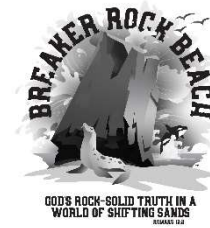
March Discipleship Training Class Schedule
