Don't forget to move your clocks forward one hour at bedtime on Saturday March 9th.

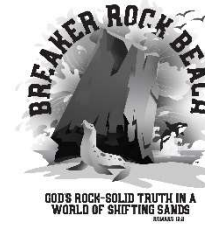
