Sometimes one word can represent the same category but mean very different things.

Three kinds of faith in James 2:14-26

Dead Faith

Passive faith that intellectually believes something and speaks about it.

Faith does something about what we think and confess.

Acts of mercy towards the poor are a sign of a faith that is alive.

Demonic Faith

Demons have faith: They believe that there is one true God worthy of worship.

Demons feel something about their faith.

What is missing from demonic faith is obedience, submission, allegiance, and action.

Biblical Faith

Two dangers when it comes to faith: One is believing works can save you. The second is believing works do not matter.

James is not contradicting Paul or anyone else in the scriptures.

There is a difference between initial justification (being made right with God) and final justification.

Our works exhibit the justification we already have in Christ.
