When I first got saved, the Holy Spirit was speaking to me about apologizing to my dad. We had a falling out and I didn't speak to him for about three years. The Holy Spirit was dealing with me so that I would make things right and honor my Dad.

The Holy Spirit will lead you into all truth. Humility is part of the kingdom, it's not about being right, it's about being humble and a peacemaker. I realized then, how important relationships are to the Holy Spirit.

I spoke about relationships last week and this Sunday I want to take a look at how the Holy Spirit teaches us by looking at the Scriptures more in depth, so we can get a better understanding of who he is.

## **Spirit of Truth**

The Holy Spirit doesn't lie or exaggerate, he speaks only the TRUTH! The Holy Spirit helps with knowing true doctrines and false ones.

John 16:13 (NIV) But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

Hebrews 4:12 (NIV) For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

1 Corinthians 2:16 (NLT) “For, “Who can know the Lord’s thoughts? Who knows enough to teach him?” But we understand these things, for we have the mind of Christ.”

John 16:14-15 (NKJV) “He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you. All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare it to you.”

## **The Holy Spirit is my Forever friend**

John 14:15-18 (NKJV) ““If you love Me, keep My commandments. And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever— the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.”

Hebrews 13:5 (KJV) Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

## **The Holy Spirit gives ability in abundance**

Acts 1:8 (NIV) But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

Ephesians 6:10 (KJV) Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.

Be strong in Lord and the power of his might, not your own strength. Live under the grace and power of the Spirit not the flesh.

## The Holy Spirit will bring things back to our remembrance

John 14:26 (NKJV) “But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.”

I’ve had the Holy Spirit give me scriptures I didn’t even know in the oddest situations, especially when I was having a stroke 2016 on my bed.

John 14:16-17 (AMP) “And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor—Counselor, Strengthener, Standby), to be with you forever— the Spirit of Truth, whom the world cannot receive [and take to its heart] because it does not see Him or know Him, but you know Him because He (the Holy Spirit) remains with you continually and will be in you.”

Here is what the Holy Spirit does daily

John 14:26-27 (AMP) “But the Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor— Counselor, Strengthener, Standby), the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name [in My place, to represent Me and act on My behalf], He will teach you all things. And He will help you remember everything that I have told you. Peace I leave with you; My [perfect] peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be afraid. [Let My perfect peace calm you in every circumstance and give you courage and strength for every challenge.]”

HE IS:

### **Helper**

A person who helps someone else.

### **Comforter**

One who gives comfort.

### **Advocate**

One who pleads the cause of another.

### **Intercessor**

Romans 8:26 (AMP) “In the same way the Spirit [comes to us and] helps us in our weakness. We do not know what prayer to offer or how to offer it as we should, but the Spirit Himself [knows our need and at the right time] intercedes on our behalf with sighs and groanings too deep for words.”

**Counselor**

A person who gives advice or counseling, a marriage counselor.

**Strengthenener**

To make stronger; give strength to.

**Standby**

To be ready to deal or assist with something.

John 14:15-18 (NKJV) ““If you love Me, keep My commandments. And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever—the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.”

**Perfect Peace**

John 14:26-27 (AMP) “But the Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor—Counselor, Strengthenener, Standby), the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name [in My place, to represent Me and act on My behalf], He will teach you all things.
