# A FEW WAYS TO REFUEL

This Sunday, is our second Rest Day of the year. In a world full of anxietyinducing busyness, the people of God should know that it is okay to take time to rest and recover from the work that has been done and refuel for the work ahead.

Below are a few ways you can practice rest throughout the week.

## Fasting (Matthew 4:2)

Start small. Push a meal back a few hours. Take time to pray or read your Bible instead of eating.

# Resting (Matthew 8:24)

Prioritize a good night's sleep on Saturday so that you come to class and worship well-rested.

Put your cellphone away for an evening. Spend time resting from distraction.

# Fellowship (Matthew 9:10)

Invite someone out to eat and/or accept an invite to eat with someone.

Next time you are at class/worship, stay awhile and talk instead of rushing out. Say "yes" to an upcoming church event.

## **Solitude (Matthew 14:13, 22-23)**

Volunteers will eat lunch together at noon. This is a great opportunity to serve the community, build relationships, minister, and share Jesus.






