Words and You

A couple of months ago, we began a series on watching our words. After a few weeks hiatus to discuss shepherds and sheep, I wanted to revisit the series to give it one final lesson that will serve to tie everything together.

When we began the series, the overall premise was that Christianity is not and cannot just be mental ascent. In other words, we cannot say “I believe this thing is true” and not let it have the power to change every part of our behavior. This is true with our words. Our words matter, they are powerful, and they are a metric by which we will be judged. Jesus said the following to a crowd that included scribes and Pharisees looking to trap him:

“I tell you, on the day of judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak, or by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.”
(Matthew 12:36-37)

As we close this series, we’ll spend time thinking about the power our words have, and the importance of thinking before we speak, not only for the sake of others, but for our own sake as well.
