The Valley of Deep Darkness

"The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake." (Psalm 23:1-3)

Psalm 23 opens with comforting words that remind us of our Shepherd and His provisions for us ("shall not want"), not only for what we need, but also through placing us where we need to be ("paths of righteousness").

"Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me." (Psalm 23:4)

The phrase "valley of the shadow of death" can be translated as "the valley of deep darkness." This would be a place of complete unknown, pitch black, and completely impossible to navigate, unless of course you had a Guide.

"You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever. (Psalm 23:5-6)

The popular Psalm closes the way it began: comfort from knowing we have a Shepherd who provides and protects. It is because of this Shepherd that we can face the unknown without fear. In life, we run into a lot of deep, dark valleys. Sometimes it's our job; other times its our kids or grandkids, or our marriages, or our health. On and on the list goes. The question isn't, "**Will** we face the unknown?", but "**How** will we face the unknown when we come to it?"

Whatever dark valley you come to, be comforted knowing that the Shepherd goes before you. -Jack Dodgen
