Acapella Singing - We sing without instrumental accompaniment in our worship assemblies. We pray you will find the music both meaningful and beautiful. We love to sing praises to God!

Contribution - Each Sunday morning, we collect a financial offering from our members. The money is used to spread the Good News of Jesus, both here and around the world, and we strive to serve the needs our local community.


