HOW WILL YOU RESPOND?

In the spring of 1989, Ellie Quo, a thirty-two-year-old Australian man decided to put his kung fu training to the test. His instructor had told him that he had reached a level where he could kill wild animals with his bare hands (this is a true story). With that information, Quo sneaked into the Melbourne Zoo and scaled the lion enclosure. The battle went as you would assume, and the next morning, zookeepers found what was left of Quo in the lion enclosure.

When the people of the Bible encountered God, or even just His messengers, the response was the same:

- Israel trembled before God at Mount Sinai (Exodus 19:16-18; 20:18-19) as did their leader Moses (Hebrews 12:18-21).
- Isaiah could only think of his sinfulness when in God's throne room (Isaiah 6:1-5).
- Ezekiel fell down, having been overwhelmed by the presence of God (Ezekiel 1:28; 3:23).
- Daniel was left terrified following His visions from God (Daniel 8:17-18; 10:7-12).

The prophet Zechariah was troubled with fear at the news of John's birth (Luke 1:11-12) as were the shepherds at the news of Jesus' birth (Luke 2:9).

We could go on and on noting more and more fear responses to God, but here's the point: **when it comes to God's presence we are faced with the choice to fall before Him as Lord or regard Him as casual.**

In his letter to Philippi, Paul encourages the church to "*work out your own salvation with fear and trembling*" (Philippians 2:12). What I love about this passage is that it comes as a form of application to what Paul wrote before, about how Jesus gave Himself to die on the cross and is now elevated to God's right hand (Philippians 2:5-11). In other words, Paul reminds us of who God is, the cross-suffering King, and then tells us how we ought to appropriately respond, in fear and following.

How will you respond to the terrifying awesomeness of God? In casual ignorance or fearful reverence? Will you walk away or follow? Scary as it is, God invites you into His presence with the goal of changing your life for the better (Philippians 2:13-15). How will you respond?
