## PHILEMON - CHOOSING A LEGACY OF LOVE

Lesson 2

Review: Paul sends two letters to Colosse by the hand of Tychicus. One is a letter to the church regarding the popular heresy of Gnosticism which also includes some practical instruction of how masters should treat their slaves and how slaves should serve their masters. The second was a personal letter to Philemon, a church leader and owner of the runaway slave Onesimus. This letter places Paul in the position of Peacemaker between the master and his slave.
