I. The Problem Behind Many Promises
A) When God makes a PROMISE - II Cor. 1:20
1) It is always PURE - Titus 1:2
2) It is always within His POWER - Rom 4:20-21
3) He will expend any PRICE - Romans 8:32
4) He will surely PERFORM it - 2 Peter 3:9
B) When men make <u>PROMISES</u>
1) The real motive may be to <u>ENHANCE</u> credibility
2) The real motive may be to <u>EXTEND</u> time
3) The real motive may be to <u>ENSURE</u> another chance
II. The Vanity Behind Many Vows - Eccl. 5:1-7
A) A vain attempt to absolve an <u>INDEBTEDNESS</u> to God
B) A vain attempt to exert <u>INFLUENCE</u> over God
C) A vain attempt to <u>IMPRESS</u> the people of God
1) God holds us to it whether or not we were SINCERE
2) God deals with our breaking a vow as a SIN
III. The Seriousness Of Oaths And Swearing - James 5:12
A) It's a presumptive APPEAL based on God's character - Matt. 5:33-
B) It's a pre-emptive <u>ATTEMPT</u> designed to silence doubt
IV. Our Word Will Be Our Bond When We Are Honest
A) Honest people count on their established reputation for honesty
B) Honest people count on God honoring their honesty
C) Honest people consider personal integrity more precious then other's opinion
D) Honest people reject the ruse of over exaggeration or falsely raising expectation
