ALL FEAR IS GONE!

Genesis 3:1-13 (NKJV)¹ Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?" ² And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden; ³ but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die.' " 4 Then the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. 5 For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." 6 So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate. ⁷ Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings. 8 And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. 9 Then the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, "Where are you?" 10 So he said, "I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself." 11 And He said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?" 12 Then the man said, "The woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I ate." 13 And the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

<u>Verse 6...</u> So when the woman saw that the tree *was* good for food, that it *was* pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make *one* wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her <u>husband with her</u>, and <u>he ate.</u>

Genesis 2:15–17 (NKJV)¹⁵ Then the LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it. ¹⁶ And the LORD God **commanded the man**, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; ¹⁷ but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it **you shall surely die."**

<u>Verse 17...</u> "but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it <u>you shall surely die."</u>

Genesis 5:5 (NKJV) So all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years; and he died.

Genesis 3:8–9 (NKJV) ⁸ And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. ⁹ Then the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, "Where *are* you?"

"Muwth" = "DIE" = 214 times in the Old Testament...

Literal Translation = "You will die die" OR "Dying you shall die"

Genesis 3:1-5 (NKJV)

PHYSICAL DEATH = When our spirit and soul become separated from our body...

<u>James 2:26 (NKJV)</u> ²⁶ For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

SPIRITUAL DEATH = When our spirit become separated from God's Spirit...

¹ Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?"

² And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat the fruit of the <u>trees of the garden</u>;

³ but of the <u>fruit</u> of <u>the tree</u> which *is* <u>in the midst of the garden</u>, <u>God has said</u>, 'You shall not eat it, <u>nor shall you touch it</u>, lest you die.'

⁴ Then the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die.

⁵ For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."

Romans 3:23 (NKJV) 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God

<u>John 3:16 (NKJV)</u> For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

<u>John 5:24 (NKJV)</u> "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life."

Genesis 2:25 (NKJV) And they were **both naked**, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

Verses 9-11... ⁹ Then the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, "Where *are* you?" ¹⁰ So he said, "I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself." ¹¹ And He said, "Who told you that you *were* naked? Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?"
