The Blood of Jesus Cleanses Us...

1 John 1:7...

“... the blood of Jesus, his Son, cleanses from all sin”

1 John 3:8...

“The son of God came to destroy the works of the devil”

The Blood of Jesus Covers Us...

Romans 4:7-8 (NKJV)

“Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven, and whose sins are covered; Blessed is the man to whom the Lord shall not impute sin”

The Blood of Jesus Protects Us

Exodus 12:7 (NLT)...

“Take some of the blood and smear it on the sides and top of the doorframes of the houses where they eat the animal”

Exodus 12:12–13 (NLT)

“12 On that night I will pass through the land of Egypt and strike down every firstborn son and firstborn male animal in the land of Egypt. I will execute judgment against all the gods of Egypt, for I am the Lord! 13 But the blood on your doorposts will serve as a sign, marking the houses where you are staying. When I see the blood, I will pass over you. This plague of death will not touch you when I strike the land of Egypt.

Exodus 12:21–23 (NLT)

“21 Then Moses called all the elders of Israel together and said to them, “Go, pick out a lamb or young goat for each of your families, and slaughter the Passover animal. 22 Drain the blood into a basin. Then take a bundle of hyssop branches and dip it into the blood. Brush the hyssop across the top and sides of the doorframes of your houses. And no one may go out through the door until morning. 23 For the Lord will pass through the land to strike down the Egyptians. But when he sees the blood on the top and sides of the doorframe, the Lord will pass over your home. He will not permit his **death angel** to enter your house and strike you down.”

There Has to Be a Blood Sacrifice...

You Have to Apply the Blood of the Sacrifice to Your Own Life...

1 John 2:3–5 (NLT)

“3 And we can be sure that we know him if we obey his commandments. 4 If someone claims, “I know God,” but doesn’t obey God’s commandments, that person is a liar and is not living in the truth. 5 But those who obey God’s word truly show how completely they love him. That is how we know we are living in him.”

Revelation 12:10–11 (NKJV)

“10 Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, “Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down. 11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.”
