UNSHAKABLE GOD

[Psalm 46:1–11](#) (NKJV)

- 1 God *is* our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble.
- 2 Therefore we will not fear, Even though the earth be removed, And though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea;
- 3 *Though* its waters roar *and* be troubled, *Though* the mountains shake with its swelling.
- 4 *There is* a river whose streams shall make glad the city of God, The holy *place* of the tabernacle of the Most High.
- 5 God *is* in the midst of her, she shall not be moved; God shall help her, just at the break of dawn.
- 6 The nations raged, the kingdoms were moved; He uttered His voice, the earth melted.
- 7 The Lord of hosts *is* with us; The God of Jacob *is* our refuge.
- 8 Come, behold the works of the Lord, Who has made desolations in the earth.
- 9 He makes wars cease to the end of the earth; He breaks the bow and cuts the spear in two; He burns the chariot in the fire.
- 10 Be still, and know that I *am* God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!
- 11 The Lord of hosts *is* with us; The God of Jacob *is* our refuge.

Verse 1 says... God *is* our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble.

Verse 10 says... Be still, and know that I *am* God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!

TROUBLE = tsarah

Meaning = distress... to feel tightness... to feel restricted...

REFUGE = Machaseh

Meaning = Shelter or hiding place or a place of safety...

Root word = Chasah

Meaning = To flee for protection...

STRENGTH = Oz...

Meaning = Might... Power... Force... Fortress

Comes from the Root Verb = Azaz...

Meaning = To prevail... To be strong... To harden...

Verse 10... Be still, and know that I *am* God

BE STILL = Raphah...

Meaning = To slacken... To let go... To cease... To drop your hands...

EZRAH = Assistance... Divine Rescue...
