
Courage over Clarity - Day 1 - What Is Faith?

Aim of Today's Study



To understand **biblical faith** as confidence in what God has promised, even when the details are hidden — and to confront our desire for clarity before obedience.

Anchor Passage

Hebrews 11:1-3

Faith is the *substance* of things hoped for and the *evidence* of things not seen.

Study and read the following Passages in context.

- 2 Corinthians 5:7 Walk by faith, not sight.
- Romans 8:24–25 Hope requires waiting for what is unseen.
- **John 20:29** Blessed are those who believe without seeing.

Summary for the Day

- Faith is not a feeling or wishful thought.
- Faith is a foundation solid confidence in God's character and promises.
- Clarity wants full understanding before moving.
- Courage steps forward because God is trustworthy, even when the path is foggy.
