


HIGH SCHOOL CHORAL SCHOLAR PROGRAM 2024-25

Christ Church Cathedral's High School Choral Scholar Program provides Cincinnati area high school students an opportunity to join the Cathedral Choir as apprentices. Successful applicants will receive intensive training in the art of fine choral singing so that they may begin the process of learning to perform at a professional level. They study a wide range of repertoire, such as works by Tallis, Brahms and Howells, as well as spirituals and music of other cultures. For their efforts, they receive a monthly scholarship throughout the academic year.

DEAN'S FORUM: FEATURING MONICA BENTON FROM CITYLINK CENTER



QUEST CLASS: PREPARING FOR SACRAMENTS



Wednesday evenings: April 17, 24, and May 1, 8, and 16.

Each night will start with dinner at 6 pm followed by formation from 6:30 - 8 pm. This is available for youth and adults interested in Confirmation, anyone interested in renewal of their faith, or those who would like a refresher of the Faith.

For the first three weeks of our six-week course, we will cover theological topics of Christianity: Why did Jesus Die? Who is the Holy Spirit? Do we really need to be baptized?

In the second three weeks of our six-week course, we will cover Episcopal topics: What is the History of the Episcopal Church? How is the Episcopal Church governed and structured compared to other denominations? And how am I to discern the next phase of my life?

These and related topics are covered in our six weeks. The course concludes on Pentecost Sunday when those who wish will be Confirmed or will Reaffirm their faith. We will use the book "Walk in Love" from Forward Movement, and a copy will be supplied to all participants. This is a pre-requisite for youth and adults who would like to be confirmed during our upcoming Confirmation service on Sunday, May 19. 

HEARTS AND HANDS PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY




Upcoming Saturday meetings: April 20, May 18, and June 15.

SLATE OF 4 BISHOPS ANNOUNCED FOR 28TH PRESIDING BISHOP OF THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH

The Episcopal Church's next presiding bishop will be chosen this June from a slate of four nominees, whose names were released April 2: Nebraska Bishop J. Scott Barker, Pennsylvania Bishop Daniel G.P. Gutiérrez, Northwestern Pennsylvania Bishop Sean Rowe, and Atlanta Bishop Robert Wright.

Those four bishops – and any additional candidates nominated by petition – will be presented for election at the 81st General Convention, which convenes June 23-28 in Louisville, Kentucky. The nominees' names will be formally submitted June 25 during a joint session of the House of Bishops and House of Deputies. On June 26, the bishops will elect, and deputies will be asked to confirm, the church's 28th presiding bishop, who will succeed Presiding Bishop Michael Curry beginning Nov. 1.
