**About Bethany School Financial Aid:** Bethany School empowers children to thrive in a diverse world. As the only Episcopal School in Ohio, it has the ability to positively impact the lives of its K-8th grade students by offering an exceptional educational experience that prioritizes character-building traits such as empathy, responsibility, independence, and a passion for service and leadership.

The school strives to create an environment that is inclusive and accessible to all children, regardless of their socioeconomic status. To achieve this, Bethany School provides financial aid to nearly 40% of its families, thanks to the generous support of community partners and supporters.

Currently, Bethany School serves 160 students, representing more than 130 families. The student body is composed of a diverse range of individuals, with 68% being of African-American descent, 22% Caucasian, and 10% coming from Multiracial backgrounds.




## UPDATE ON FUTURE SUNDAY MORNING LECTIONARY BIBLE STUDIES

Exciting News! **Starting April 7th**, we are adding Bible Study after 10:00 am and The Noon services. Every week there will be 3 Sunday Lectionary Bible Studies available: 9:00 am in the Chapel, 11:30 am in the Vestry Room, and 1:15 pm in the Chapel.

After each Sunday morning service, we will study the passages assigned for the day. CK Wang has faithfully hosted the study after the 8:00 am service for many years. He will continue to do so. We will add the parish clergy to take the offering after the 10:00 am and Noon services. Grab a snack and come study the scripture assigned for the day!



## QUEST CLASS: PREPARING FOR SACRAMENTS



**Six Wednesday evenings: April 10, 17, 24, and May 1, 8, and 16.**

Each night will start with dinner at 6 pm followed by formation from 6:30 - 8 pm. This is available for youth and adults interested in Confirmation, anyone interested in renewal of their faith, or those who would like a refresher of the Faith.

For the first three weeks of our six-week course, we will cover theological topics of Christianity: Why did Jesus Die? Who is the Holy Spirit? Do we really need to be baptized?

In the second three weeks of our six-week course, we will cover Episcopal topics: What is the History of the Episcopal Church? How is the Episcopal Church governed and structured compared to other denominations? And how am I to discern the next phase of my life?

These and related topics are covered in our six weeks. The course concludes on Pentecost Sunday when those who wish will be Confirmed or will Reaffirm their faith. We will use the book “Walk in Love” from Forward Movement, and a copy will be supplied to all participants.
