THE TAFT LECTURE SERIES PRESENTS: DR. ROBERT BULLARD

Professor Bullard is often called the "father of environmental justice." He is also co-founder of the HBCU-CBO Gulf Coast Equity Consortium and HBCU Climate Change Consortium and co-chair of the National Black Environmental Justice Network. He is the author of eighteen books that address environmental racism, urban land use, housing, transportation, sustainability, smart growth, climate justice, and community resilience.



A MESSAGE FROM FACILITIES DIRECTOR, MATT HORNSBY

In early December a cathedral staff member reported seeing a slight shifting of 2 windows in their 4th floor office. I immediately contacted Schaefer Engineering to conduct a structural inspection of the 4th-floor north wall of the parish house. Schaefers inspection revealed a deteriorating pier behind the brick facade. The engineer assured us that there was no immediate danger, however it needed to be repaired as soon as possible. **Work began on February 5th and is expected to take five weeks.**

Unfortunately, several areas of the cathedral need to be closed during construction. Closed areas include the 5th-floor gymnasium, 4th-floor NE office, 3rd-floor forum room, and the Library. *Please note that during this time Sunday Coffee Hours will be moved to the Undercroft.* If you have an event or meeting scheduled in the library or 3rd-floor forum room during this time, Michelle Hornsby will be reaching out if you have not already been contacted. She will provide you with the new space where these meetings or events will be relocating to.

BLACK HISTORY MONTH WEEK 4 FEATURED NOTABLE FIGURE: BISHOP BARBARA HARRIS



Barbara Clementine Harris (June 12, 1930 – March 13, 2020) was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania where she attended Saint Barnabas Episcopal Church. Motivated by the vital issues of the times, she moved to the more liberal Church of the Advocate in the 1960s. Alongside her busy career as chief public relations executive at the Sun Oil Company, Harris was a devoted participant in the life of her church which became the center of the black protest movement in Philadelphia. An ardent supporter of the civil rights movement, Harris participated in voter registration efforts and the Selma march with Martin Luther King, Jr.

Bishop Harris became the first female bishop in the Episcopal Church shortly after the Lambeth Conference, the oncedecade meeting of international Anglican leaders, resolved in 1988 that the ordination of women as bishops was the prerogative of each autonomous province of the Communion. Elected later that year to the position of Bishop Suffragan of Massachusetts, she defeated four other candidates, including one other female priest. Her election was controversial, causing some conservative priests to break ties with the Church. Protests ensued. Determined not to allow the controversy to interfere with her duties as Bishop, Harris stood up to the challenges brought on by her new position.
