THE DAY OF PENTECOST AND HOLY CONFIRMATION



Today we celebrate the Day of Pentecost! One of the seven principal feasts of the church year, which comes fifty days after Easter Day, Pentecost marks the descent of the Holy Spirit on Jesus' followers and the revelation that the Gospel is for all nations.

It is often referred to as the "birthday of the Church." Choral music at the 10:00 am service will include "Come Down, O Love Divine" (William H. Harris) and "Loquebantur variis linguis" (Palestrina).

After four weeks of Episcopal 101, and six weeks of Episcopal 102 (also known as Quest Classes) we have several people presenting themselves to be Confirmed, Received, or to Reaffirm their faith. These three actions are each an adult commitment to Jesus Christ. Confirmation is for those who are to receive the laying on of hands by Bishop White and given the Holy Spirit to empower their Christian walk. Reception is for those who have already been confirmed by a bishop in another denomination and wish to be received into the fellowship of the Episcopal Church. Reaffirmation is for those who have been confirmed by the Episcopal Church and wish to renew their commitment to Jesus Christ.

They study a wide range of repertoire, such as works by Tallis, Brahms and Howells, as well as spirituals and music of other cultures. For their efforts, they receive a monthly scholarship throughout the academic year.

The week concludes with a student art show for friends and family! Camp Create runs from 9 am – 3 pm Monday through Friday, June 17th-21st. What will a typical day look like?

- First class: Each session will have a teacher going through some cool new art project, craft, or skill used to bring our imaginations to life.

- Second class: Teachers will be switched to go to a different group to start a new project.

NEWS FOR CATHEDRAL KIDS! (AND THEIR GROWN-UPS)





LGBTQIA+ AFFINITY GROUP MONTHLY HAPPY HOUR


