LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Hope For a Secure House because of the Child Called Eternal Father Isaiah 9:6

The name, "Eternal Father" implies four hope filled actions of One who provides an everlasting, secure house for His people

a House for His People

A. Consider the Isaiah context of "Father/Son/House /Dynasty"

Isaiah 7:1-17, 8:14, 18 - Now it came about in the days of Ahaz, <u>the</u> <u>son</u> of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, that Rezin the king of Aram and Pekah <u>the son of Remaliah</u>, king of Israel...When it was reported to the <u>house of David</u>...Then the Lord said to Isaiah, "Go out now to meet Ahaz, <u>you and your son</u>...on account of the fierce anger of Rezin and Aram and the <u>son of Remaliah</u>...Let us go up against Judah ... set up the <u>son of Tabeel as king (new dynasty)</u> in the midst of it,...Then he said, "Listen now, <u>O house of David!</u>...The Lord will bring...<u>on your father's house</u>...But to <u>both the houses of Israel</u>, a... Behold, I (Isaiah) and <u>the children</u> whom the Lord has given me are for signs and wonders in Israel from the Lord of hosts, <u>who dwells on</u> <u>Mount Zion (DAVID's HOUSE)</u>."

B. Consider what God had promised to David (2 Samuel 7)

2 Samuel 7:1-14 - Now it came about when the king (David) lived in his house...that the king (David) said to Nathan the prophet, "See now, I dwell in a house of cedar, but the ark of God dwells within tent curtains." But in the same night the word of the Lord came to Nathan, saying, "Go and say to My servant David, '... I have been with you wherever you have gone...and I will make you a great name...I will also appoint a place for My people Israel and will plant them, that they may live in their own place ...' The Lord also declares to you that the Lord <u>will make a house for you.</u> When your days (David's) are complete and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your descendant after you, who will come forth from you, and I will establish his kingdom. <u>He shall build a house for My name, and I will establish the</u> throne of his kingdom forever. I will be a father to him and he will be a son to Me; Your house and your kingdom shall endure before Me forever; your throne shall be established forever."

II. _____ with the House of His People

What is the tension in this text? "For a child will be born to us, a son will be given...and his name will be called... eternal father."

A. A child that is given, a son that is be born (Isaiah 9:6)

B. Immanuel – God with us (Isaiah 7:14)

Isaiah 7:14 - Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name

Immanuel (God with us).

NOTES

Matthew 22:41-46 - Now while the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them a question: "What do you think about the Christ, whose son is He?" They said to Him, "The son of David." He said to them, "Then how does David in the Spirit call Him 'Lord,' saying, 'The Lord said to my Lord, sit at My right hand, until I put Your enemies beneath Your feet'? If David then calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his son?" No one was able to answer Him a word, nor did anyone dare from that day on to ask Him another question.

"We catch sight of a new key principle – the power of the Higher, just in so far as it is truly Higher, to come down, the power of the greater to include the less ... Everywhere the great enters the little – its power to do so is almost the test of its greatness." (C. S. Lewis, Miracles, commenting on the miracle of the incarnation)

III. Becomes the Life-Giving ______ for His People

Isaiah 53:10 - He will see His offspring...

John 1:12-13 - But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

Hebrew 2:11-18 - For both He who sanctifies and those who are sanctified are <u>all from one Father</u>; for which reason He is not ashamed to <u>call them brethren</u>, saying, "I will proclaim Your name to My brethren, In the midst of the congregation I will sing Your praise." And again, "I will put My trust in Him." And again, <u>"Behold, I and the children whom God</u> <u>has given Me."</u> Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, and might free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives. For assuredly He does not give help to angels, but He gives help to the descendant of Abraham. Therefore, He had to be made like His brethren in all things, so that He might become a merciful and <u>faithful high priest in things pertaining</u> to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people. For since He Himself was tempted in that which He has suffered, He is able to come to the aid of those who are tempted.

IV. _____ to Be the King Forever of His People – Isaiah 9:7

Isaiah 9:7 - There will be no end to the increase of His government or of peace, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness from then on and forevermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will accomplish this.
