READ: GENESIS 17:15-17,19, 21; 21:1-8; 22:1-19

Ask Your Child:

- Why did God ask Abraham to sacrifice Isaac? *To reveal the quality of his faith*.
- How did Abraham respond? By obeying, he showed that he loved God more than anything else.
