Stewardship - God-given responsibility with accountability

Four Principles of Stewardship

- 1. God owns everything, you own nothing

I. God's Ownership Should Result in (1 Chronicles 29:10-13)
A. Because He is our heavenly Father
<b>1 Chronicles 29:10</b> - So David blessed the Lord in the sight of all the assembly; and David said, "Blessed are You, O Lord God of Israel our father, forever and ever."

II. God's Ownership Should Result in (1 Chronicles 29:14-17)
A. Because our good come from God's good hand
<b>1 Chronicles 29:14</b> - But who am I and who are my people that we should be able to offer as generously as this? For all things come from You, and from Your hand we have given You.

<b>Luke 12:20-21</b> - But God said to him, "You fool! This very night your soul is required of you; and now who will own what you have prepared? So is the man who stores up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God."
