Romans 1:1–7 (NASB95) ¹Paul, a **bond-servant** of Christ Jesus, called as an **apostle**, **set apart** for the **gospel of God**, ²which **He promised beforehand through His prophets** in the holy Scriptures, ³concerning **His Son**, who was born of a **descendant of David** according to the flesh, ⁴who was **declared the Son of God** with power by the **resurrection from the dead**, according to the **Spirit of holiness, Jesus Christ our Lord**,

⁵through whom we have received **grace** and apostleship to bring about **the obedience of faith** among all the Gentiles for His name’s sake, ⁶among whom you also are **the called** of Jesus Christ; ⁷to all who are beloved of God in Rome, called as saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
