Sunday, February 3, 2019 | ACTS 1:1-11 (NASB)

1. ESTABLISHED BY HIS GOSPEL TO GO.

Acts 1:1-11 (NASB) ¹The first account I composed, Theophilus, about all that Jesus began to do and teach, ²until the day when He was taken up *to heaven*, after He had by the Holy Spirit given orders to the apostles whom He had chosen. ³To these **He also presented Himself alive after His suffering**, by many **convincing proofs, appearing to them over a period of forty days** and speaking of the things concerning the kingdom of God. ⁴Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, “Which,” *He said*, “you heard of from Me; ⁵for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with **the Holy Spirit** not many days from now.”

2. EMPOWERED BY HIS SPIRIT TO GO.

⁶So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, “Lord, is it at this time You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?” ⁷He said to them, “It is not for you to know times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority; ⁸**but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth.**”

3. ENCOURAGED BY HIS RETURN TO GO.

⁹And after He had said these things, He was lifted up while they were looking on, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. ¹⁰And as they were gazing intently into the sky while He was going, behold, two men in white clothing stood beside them. ¹¹They also said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into the sky? **This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in just the same way as you have watched Him go into heaven.**”
