### 1. GOD'S WILL CONQUERS OUR FEARS.

**Matthew 1:18-25 (NASB)** <sup>18</sup> Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: when His mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child by the Holy Spirit. <sup>19</sup> And Joseph her husband, being a righteous man and not wanting to disgrace her, planned to send her away secretly. <sup>20</sup> But when he had considered this, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, **do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife; for the Child who has been conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit.**

### 2. GOD'S FORGIVENESS CONQUERS OUR FEARS.

<sup>21</sup> "She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, **for He will save His people from their sins.**"

### 3. GOD'S PRESENCE CONQUERS OUR FEARS.

<sup>22</sup> Now all this took place to fulfill what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet:

<sup>23</sup> **"BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN SHALL BE WITH CHILD AND SHALL BEAR A SON, AND THEY SHALL CALL HIS NAME IMMANUEL," which translated means, "GOD WITH US."** <sup>24</sup> And Joseph awoke from his sleep and did as the angel of the Lord commanded him, and took *Mary* as his wife, <sup>25</sup> but kept her a virgin until she gave birth to a Son; and he called His name Jesus.
