1. WORSHIP GOD BY <u>IMITATING LEADERSHIP</u>.

Hebrews 13:7–16 (NASB95) ⁷Remember those who led you, who spoke the word of God to you; and considering the result of their conduct, imitate their faith.

2. WORSHIP GOD BY AVOIDING LEGALISM.

⁸Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. ⁹Do not be carried away by varied and strange teachings; for it is good for the heart to be strengthened by grace, not by foods, through which those who were so occupied were not benefited. ¹⁰We have an altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat. ¹¹For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the holy place by the high priest as an offering for sin, are burned outside the camp. ¹²Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people through His own blood, suffered outside the gate.

3. WORSHIP GOD BY <u>BUILDING A LEGACY</u>.

¹³So, let us go out to Him outside the camp, bearing His reproach. ¹⁴For here we do not have a lasting city, but we are seeking the city which is to come. ¹⁵Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name. ¹⁶And do not neglect doing good and sharing, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.
