Acts 2:40-47 (NASB) ⁴⁰ And with many other words he solemnly testified and kept on exhorting them, saying, “**Be saved from this perverse generation!**” ⁴¹ So then, those who had received his word were **baptized**; and that day there were **added about three thousand souls**. ⁴² They were continually **devoting themselves** to the **apostles’ teaching** and to **fellowship**,
