Sunday, April 7, 2019 | John 8:1-11 (NASB)

1. EVERYONE IS CAUGHT IN SIN.

John 8:1-11 (NASB) ¹ But Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. ² Early in the morning He came again into the temple, and all the people were coming to Him; and He sat down and *began* to teach them. ³ The scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman caught in adultery, and having set her in the center *of the court*, ⁴ they said to Him, “Teacher, this woman has been caught in adultery, in the very act. ⁵ “Now in the Law Moses commanded us to stone such women; what then do You say?” ⁶ They were saying this, testing Him, so that they might have grounds for accusing Him. **But Jesus stooped down and with His finger wrote on the ground.** ⁷ But when they persisted in asking Him, He straightened up, and said to them, **“He who is without sin among you, let him *be the first to throw a stone at her.*”** ⁸ Again He stooped down and wrote on the ground. ⁹ When they heard it, they *began* to go out one by one, beginning with the older ones, and He was left alone, and the woman, where she was, in the center *of the court*.

2. ANYONE CAN BE SET FREE FROM SIN.

¹⁰ Straightening up, Jesus said to her, “Woman, where are they? Did no one condemn you?” ¹¹ She said, **“No one, Lord.”** And Jesus said, **“I do not condemn you, either. Go. From now on sin no more.”**
