1. DETERMINE THE ROOT.

James 1:19-22 (NASB) ¹⁹ *This* you know, my beloved brethren. **But everyone must be quick to hear, slow to speak and slow to anger;**

Ephesians 4:26-27 (NASB) ²⁶ BE ANGRY, AND *yet* DO NOT SIN; do not let the sun go down on your anger, ²⁷ and do not give the devil an opportunity.

2. ACCEPT THE REALITY.

²⁰ for the anger of man does not achieve the righteousness of God.

3. OBEY THE REMEDY.

²¹ Therefore, putting aside all filthiness and *all* that remains of wickedness, in humility receive the word implanted, which is able to save your souls. ²² But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves.
