1. KNOW HIM.

John 1:35-42 (NASB) ³⁵ **Again the next day** John was standing with two of his disciples, ³⁶ **and he looked at Jesus as He walked**, and *said, **“Behold, the Lamb of God!”** ³⁷ The two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus. ³⁸ And Jesus turned and saw them following, and *said to them, **“What do you seek?”** They said to Him, “Rabbi (which translated means Teacher), where are You staying?” ³⁹ He *said to them, **“Come, and you will see.”** So they came and saw where He was staying; **and they stayed with Him that day**, for it was about the tenth hour.

2. MAKE HIM KNOWN.

⁴⁰ One of the two who heard John *speak* and followed Him, was **Andrew**, Simon Peter’s brother. ⁴¹ **He *found first his own brother Simon** and *said to him, **“We have found the Messiah”** (which translated means Christ). ⁴² **He brought him to Jesus.** Jesus looked at him and said, “You are Simon the son of John; you shall be called Cephass” (which is translated Peter).
