



## “MAKE HIM KNOWN”

Sunday, October 14, 2018 | John 1:35-42 (NASB)

### 1. KNOW HIM.

**John 1:35-42 (NASB)** <sup>35</sup> Again the next day John was standing with two of his disciples, <sup>36</sup> and he looked at Jesus as He walked, and \*said, “Behold, the Lamb of God!” <sup>37</sup> The two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus. <sup>38</sup> And Jesus turned and saw them following, and \*said to them, “What do you seek?” They said to Him, “Rabbi (which translated means Teacher), where are You staying?” <sup>39</sup> He \*said to them, “Come, and you will see.” So they came and saw where He was staying; **and they stayed with Him that day**, for it was about the tenth hour.

### 2. MAKE HIM KNOWN.

<sup>40</sup> One of the two who heard John speak and followed Him, was **Andrew**, Simon Peter’s brother. <sup>41</sup> He \*found first his own brother **Simon** and \*said to him, “We have found the Messiah” (which translated means Christ). <sup>42</sup> He brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, “You are Simon the son of John; you shall be called Cephas” (which is translated Peter).
