1. THE GOSPEL AND OUR MINDS.

Romans 12:1–8 (NASB95) ¹Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to **present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice**, acceptable to God, **which is your spiritual service of worship.** ²And do not be conformed to this world, but **be transformed by the renewing of your mind,** so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

2. THE GOSPEL AND OUR MEMBERSHIP.

³For through the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment, as God has allotted to each a measure of faith. ⁴For just as we have many members in one body and all the members do not have the same function, ⁵so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.

3. THE GOSPEL AND OUR MINISTRY.

⁶Since we have **gifts** that differ according to the grace given to us, each of us is to exercise them accordingly: if **prophecy**, according to the proportion of his faith; ⁷if **service**, in his **serving**; or he who **teaches**, in his teaching; ⁸or he who **exhorts**, in his exhortation; he who **gives**, with liberality; he who **leads**, with diligence; he who shows **mercy**, with cheerfulness.
