Philippians 2:1-11 (NASB)

1. SERVING DISPLAYS THE GOSPEL.

Philippians 2:1-11 (NASB95) ¹Therefore if there is any **encouragement in Christ**, if there is any **consolation of love**, if there is any **fellowship of the Spirit**, if any **affection and compassion**, ² make my joy complete by being of **the same mind**, maintaining **the same love**, **united in spirit**, intent on **one purpose**.

2. SERVING BLESSES OTHERS.

³ Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but **with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves**; ⁴ do not *merely* look out for your own personal interests, but **also for the interests of others**.

3. SERVING HONORS CHRIST.

⁵ **Have this attitude in yourselves** which was also in Christ Jesus, ⁶ who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, ⁷ but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men. ⁸ Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. ⁹ For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰ so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
