SONG OF GATHERING & PREPARATION

The people of God always sang as they ascended the hill in Jerusalem up to the temple to worship (see Psalms 120-134). We, as well, prepare our hearts, minds, and bodies for worship by singing about the God we serve.

Worthy Of Your Name

CALL TO WORSHIP | Romans 8:28-29 (ESV)

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose. For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.

PRAYER OF ADORATION & CONFESSION

We pray together praising God for who He really is (Adoration) and admitting our inability to live up to what He expects of us (Confession).

ASSURANCE OF PARDON | 1 Peter 5:6-10 (ESV)

We read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you. Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. Resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brotherhood throughout the world. And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.

We respond to the good news of God's mercy and grace for us in Jesus by giving generously to the work of this church and the kingdom of God.

CONFESSION OF FAITH

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE & SERMON OUTLINE

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Luke 22:7-23 (ESV)

Title: The Instincts of Jesus: His Willingness to Suffer

Teacher: Tim Rice

⁷ Then came the day of Unleavened Bread, on which the Passover lamb had to be sacrificed. ⁸ So Jesus sent Peter and John, saying, "Go and prepare the Passover for us, that we may eat it." ⁹ They said to him, "Where will you have us prepare it?" ¹⁰ He said to them, "Behold, when you have entered the city, a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him into the house that he enters ¹¹ and tell the master of the house, 'The Teacher says to you, Where is the guest room, where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?' ¹² And he will show you a large upper room furnished; prepare it there." ¹³ And they went and found it just as he had told them, and they prepared the Passover. ¹⁴ And when the hour came, he reclined at table, and the apostles with him. ¹⁵ And he said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. ¹⁶ For I tell you I will not eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God." ¹⁷ And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he said, "Take this, and divide it among yourselves. ¹⁸ For I tell you that from now on I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." ¹⁹ And he took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." ²⁰ And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood. ²¹ But behold, the hand of him who betrays me is with me on the table. ²² For the Son of Man goes as it has been determined, but woe to that man by whom he is betrayed!" ²³ And they began to question one another, which of them it could be who was going to do this.

Intro: What separates an accident from a plan?

GOD'S DELIBERATE PLAN

What do we learn about Jesus' will to suffer to save His people?

OUR ARTFUL DODGE

How are we ill prepared to navigate or endure suffering, *let alone thrive in it?*

WHAT SHAPES HOW WE ACT

What if God can turn wicked deeds to His good, saving purposes?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

1. Worship the LORD for His sovereign power, wisdom and goodness, especially in His work through suffering. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit that He is in control and that no one can possibly unseat Him.
2. How have you lived as if you're a victim and that God is your greatest offender, *when in reality we have betrayed Him?* Confess your foolishness and unbelief to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and change your heart.
3. Give thanks to Jesus for choosing to suffer to meet your needs – to remove your guilt and makes you whole when no one else would. And thank Him for loving and enduring with you when no one else could.
4. Who do you know that has suffered and it has them discouraged? Pray for them, asking the Lord to help and encourage them in Christ; especially that they see how Jesus can turn even *death* into redemption.
5. Ask the Holy Spirit to grow you in wisdom. Pray for a heart to read God's Word every day; to know the LORD more and more; and to grow in true loyalty to Him as your good King and Savior.
