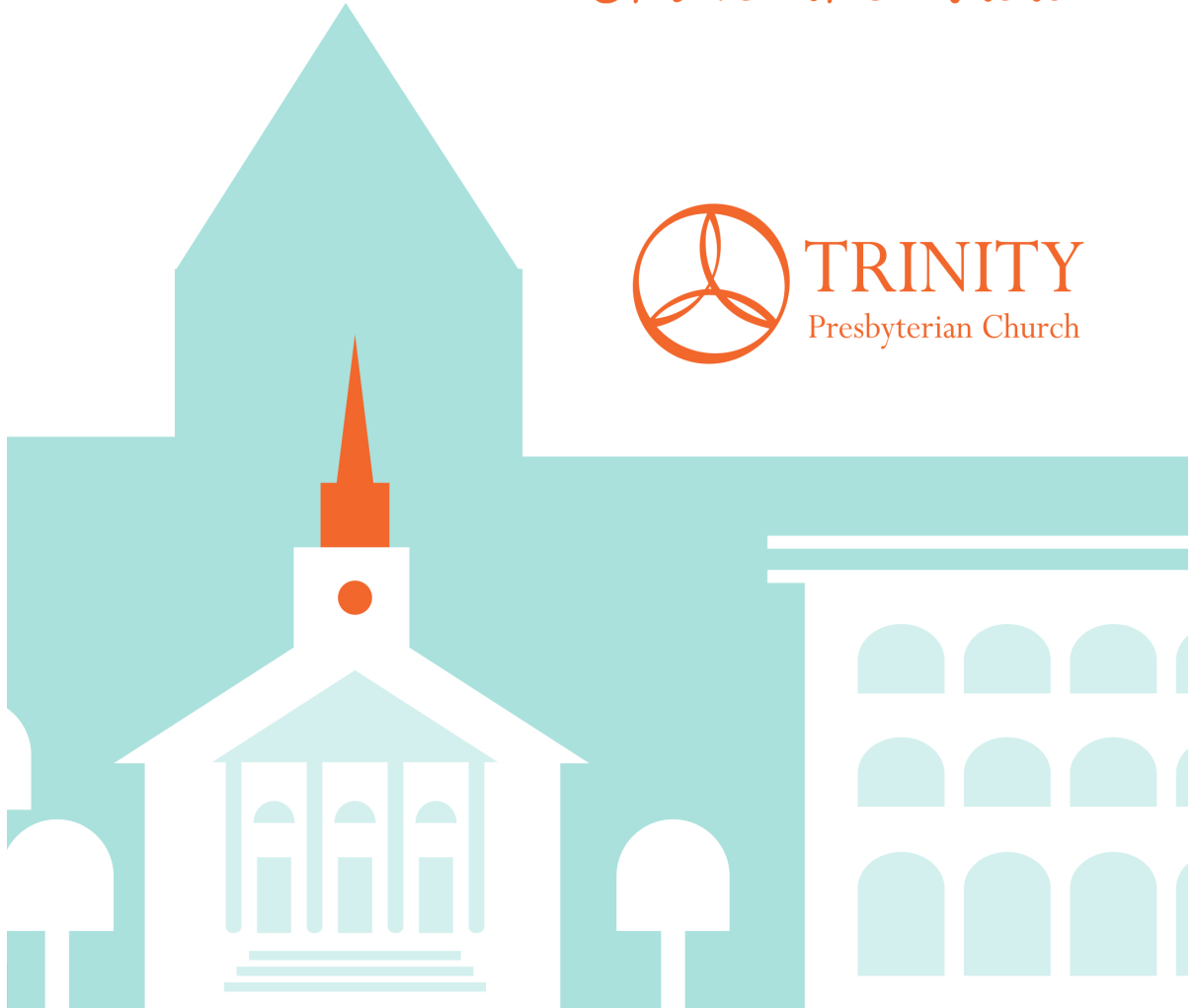

Call to Worship

Prayer of Adoration and Confession – Luke Wolfe

We pray together praising God for who He really is (Adoration) and admitting our inability to live up to what He expects of us (Confession).

Assurance of Pardon

We again read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 12:1-3 (ESV)

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider him who endured from sinners such hostility against himself, so that you may not grow weary or fainthearted.

Confession of Faith

As an expression of our faith in Jesus Christ in solidarity with his people, we declare the substance of what we believe.

The Apostle's Creed:

I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified dead and buried; he descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

Sacrament of the Lord's Supper

The ritual meal of Communion is a sign and seal of the grace we have in Jesus. That is, it symbolizes the work Christ did for our salvation (sign) and communicates the grace and mercy we have been given (seal) as a result of His death and resurrection.

Seasons of the Cross

The color green: a sign of life. In the plant kingdom, growth within an organism extends outward into tender green shoots, culminating in a blossom of life as a plant goes to seed, multiplying itself over and over again. On the cross, green is a symbol of the ongoing work of Christ in our hearts. Starting with the smallest seed, His work grows in us over a lifetime, shooting tendrils outward into the lives of others as His kingdom grows. Christ's work is ongoing, vibrant and alive in the hearts of His people.

Scripture Passage and Sermon Outline

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Psalm 23 (ESV)

Title: The LORD's Guidance & Protection

Teacher: Tim Rice

¹ The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. ² He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. ³ He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. ⁴ Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. ⁵ You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. ⁶ Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

Intro: How does discipline fit with God's love and grace?

GOD'S TOOLS FOR OUR GOOD

What does it mean – "Your rod and your staff they comfort me"?

OUR PRIDE (OR FEAR)

How does pride raise the volume on your own voice and diminish others?

HIS EVER-PRESENT GRACE

How does the LORD work to save us from sin's effects?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US...

1. Worship the LORD that He leads and protects us as His people. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit that no one and no thing can possibly overcome His infinite, sovereign power and goodness (He IS holy).
2. How have you lived doubting either that you're really wrong (pride) or that you're really safe (fear)? Confess your unbelief to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and secure you as only He can.
3. Give thanks to Jesus for the miracle of His work to defeat every threat against us. Thank Him for dying to defeat your guilt (which would justly end in hell), and for His resurrection to defeat death.
4. Who do you know that lives over-confidently? Pray for them, asking the Lord to help them see their folly, and their need for His correction and His guidance.
5. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you to welcome Jesus' correction where you're idolatrous (*I'm wrong*), and to secure you where you're afraid (*I'm safe in Christ*). Pray that the Holy Spirit would help you trust Jesus to outstrip every competing promise or lie.
