Seasons of the Cross

Black for Lent: The weeks from Ash Wednesday leading up to Palm Sunday on the church calendar have historically been set aside as a time to reflect and ponder the crushing weight of our sin, which is inescapable but for Christ. Black for mourning – a representation of our imminent spiritual and physical death apart from Christ. How wonderful, how marvelous that though our sin was great, His grace was greater – and the story does not end there.

"For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 6:23 (ESV)

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: James 4:1-5 (ESV)

Title: The Seven Deadly Sins: Envy

Teacher: Tim Rice

¹ What causes quarrels and what causes fights among you? Is it not this, that your passions are at war within you? ² You desire and do not have, so you murder. You covet and cannot obtain, so you fight and quarrel. You do not have, because you do not ask. ³ You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions. ⁴ You adulterous people! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. ⁵ Or do you suppose it is to no purpose that the Scripture says, "He yearns jealously over the spirit that he has made to dwell in us"?

Intro: How ubiquitous is envy? Just look at advertising...

DOUBTING GOD'S SUFFICIENCY

If pride was unbelief or contention with God's supremacy, what is envy?

IOY & CONTENTMENT How does the Gospel source a life of joyful contentment? YOU CAN PRAY WITH US... 1. Worship the LORD for His sufficiency. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit that He is infinite, and therefore He cannot be exhausted or ever run out. 2. How have you lived ungratefully, envious or selfishly? Confess your unbelief to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and to fill your heart as only He can. 3. Give thanks to Jesus for His miraculous generosity and sufficiency. Thank Him that He is enough and that He has done enough by His atoning work and the gift of His Spirit. 4. Who do you know that lives grumbling, complaining or envying others? Pray for them, asking the Lord to open their eyes to their unbelief AND His glorious sufficiency. 5. Read 1 Timothy 6:6-11. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you the fruit of love, especially because of His loving sufficiency. Pray for such joy at His unending love and provision that you would live in grateful love and generosity.

JESUS IS ENOUGH
