

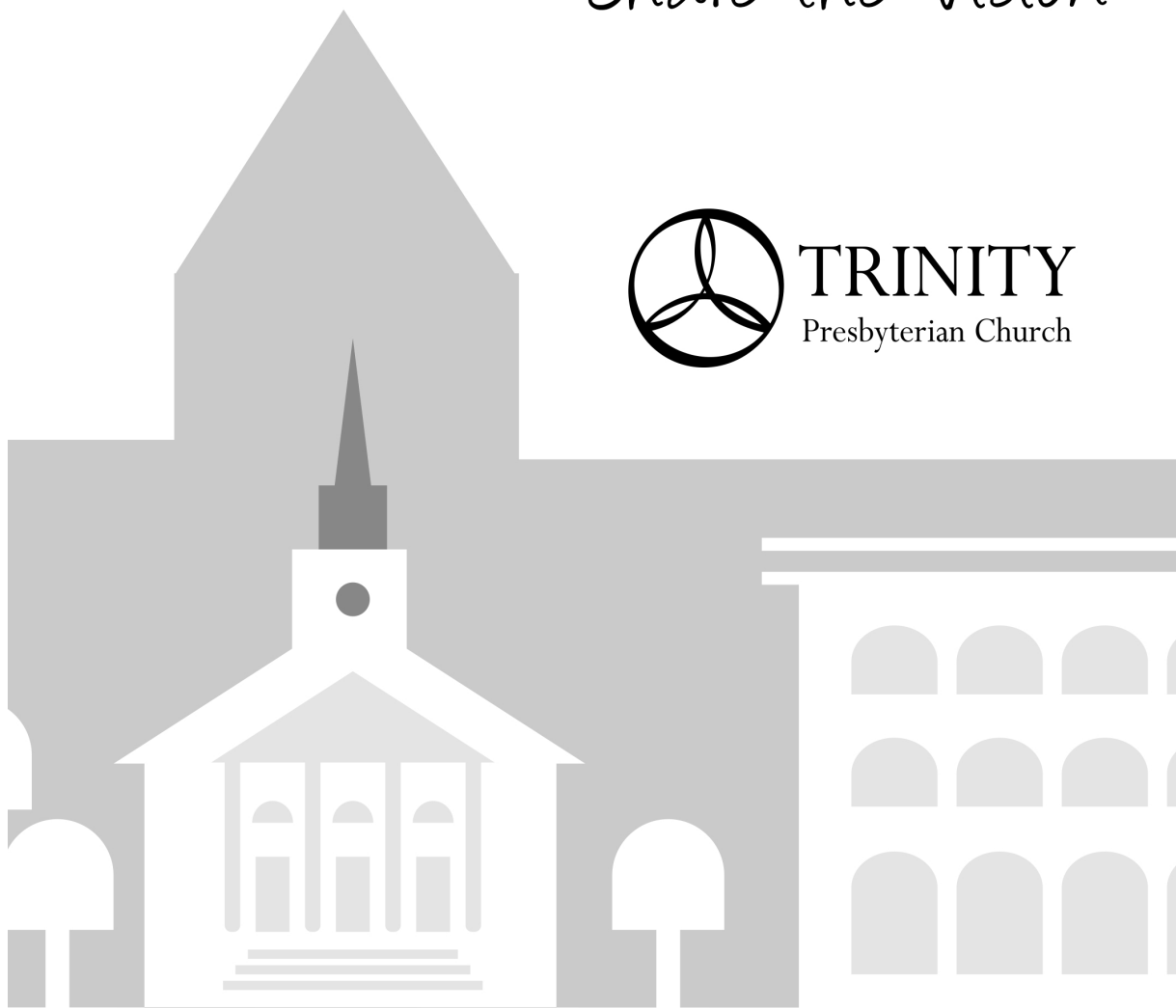

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

Seasons of the Cross

The color green: A sign of life. In the plant kingdom, growth within an organism extends outward into tender green shoots, culminating in a blossom of life and a plant goes to seed, multiplying itself over and over again. On the cross, green is a symbol of the ongoing work of Christ in our hearts. Starting with the smallest seed, His work grows in us over our lifetime, shooting tendrils outward into the lives of others as His kingdom grows. Christ's work is ongoing, vibrant and alive in the hearts of His people.

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Proverbs 1:5, 7; 3:34-35; 15:33, 16:6; 23:17-18 (ESV)

Title: Humility & Awe

Teacher: Tim Rice

1:5 Let the wise hear and increase in learning, and the one who understands obtain guidance, ... 7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction. ... 3:34 Toward the scorners he is scornful, but to the humble he gives favor. 35 The wise will inherit honor, but fools get disgrace. ... 15:33 The fear of the LORD is instruction in wisdom, and humility comes before honor. ... 16:6 By steadfast love and faithfulness iniquity is atoned for, and by the fear of the LORD one turns away from evil. ... 23:17 Let not your heart envy sinners, but continue in the fear of the LORD all the day. 18 Surely there is a future, and your hope will not be cut off.

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

1. Worship the LORD for His holiness and authority. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit that He is good and wise in all His ways and that He is also unsurpassed by any creature, including rebellious ones.
2. How have you treated God's commands as suggestions, avoiding counsel or resenting instruction? Confess your pride and foolishness to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and to transform you in your character.
3. Give thanks to Jesus as the Most High that He came to the lowest to save people like us. *Thank Him for saving us from God's just punishment* (by His death) *and from ruin* (by always honoring His Father's commands).
4. *Who do you know that suffers for honoring authority?* Pray for the Lord to strengthen them in their fight, and that He would give them vision of the glorious future He has promised us through His resurrection.
5. Ask the Holy Spirit to grow in you such a regard for His authority that you can joyfully trust Him in any command. Ask for His wisdom to work into you His perspective and hope.
