SONG OF GATHERING & PREPARATION

The people of God always sang as they ascended the hill in Jerusalem up to the temple to worship (see Psalms 120-134). We, as well, prepare our hearts, minds, and bodies for worship by singing about the God we serve.

King Of Kings

CALL TO WORSHIP | Hebrews 3:12-13 (ESV)

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

PRAYER OF ADORATION & CONFESSION

We pray together praising God for who He really is (Adoration) and admitting our inability to live up to what He expects of us (Confession).

ASSURANCE OF PARDON | Luke 11:2-4, 9-13 (ESV)

We read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

And he said to them, "When you pray, say: "Father, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread, and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation." ... And I tell you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. What father among you, if his son asks for a fish, will instead of a fish give him a serpent; or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE & SERMON OUTLINE

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: James 5:13-20 (ESV)

Title: Faithful Character In Crisis: Prayers of Faith

Teacher: Tim Rice

¹³ Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing praise. ¹⁴ Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. ¹⁵ And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. ¹⁶ Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working. ¹⁷ Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed fervently that it might not rain, and for three years and six months it did not rain on the earth. ¹⁸ Then he prayed again, and heaven gave rain, and the earth bore its fruit. ¹⁹ My brothers, if anyone among you wanders from the truth and someone brings him back, ²⁰ let him know that whoever brings back a sinner from his wandering will save his soul from death and will cover a multitude of sins.

Intro: Elijah prayed in context of calling people to repentance ...

HOW THINGS GO WRONG

How can we malfunction when suffering, internally or externally?

JESUS, OUR GOOD SHEPHERD Why does it matter that Jesus *engages* with His Father – and us?

LIVING ENGAGED

What if we respond in faith, trusting Jesus and what He has done for us?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

- 1. Worship the LORD for His willingness to listen to you. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit that, in Christ, He hears us receiving our praise, welcoming our confession, and answering our cries for help.
- 2. How (or in what circumstances) are you practically prayerless? Confess your pride and unbelief to Jesus, asking Him to save you here also that He would forgive you and work a growing confidence in Him into your heart.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for His work to "bring sinners back" making it possible for you to be God's adopted child! Thank Him that rather than staying remote and uninvolved, that He engaged in the work and fight so we could be saved.
- 4. Who do you know that is in need, whether a co-worker, neighbor, or friend? Ask the Father to hear you on their behalf, and to work in their life to give them His joy and Presence.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you His fruit of love and goodness. Read again Luke 11:1-13 and pray for the Spirit to help you trust the access you're given in Christ and to pray as you should.


