

### Confession of Faith

As an expression of our faith in Jesus Christ in solidarity with his people, we declare the substance of what we believe.

From the Heidelberg Catechism:

- Q. 77. Where has Christ promised that he will feed and nourish believers with his body and blood just as surely as they eat of this broken bread and drink of this cup?
- A. In the institution of the Lord's Supper which reads: "...that the Lord Jesus, on the night when he was betrayed, took a loaf of bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, 'This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me.' In the same way he took the cup also, after supper, saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.' For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes."

This promise is repeated by Paul in these words: "The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a sharing in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a sharing in the body of Christ? Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread.

## Seasons of the Cross

Green: The colors of the various seasons of the Christian year express the mood or feeling of that season. Green expresses the ongoing work of God and our participation in him and in his work. Particularly, in this season after Pentecost, we strive to live in and through the power and presence of the Holy Spirit - praying and living so as to display and declare the glory of Jesus in all we do.

### Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Psalm 23 (ESV)

Title: Paths of Righteousness

Teacher: Tim Rice

<sup>1</sup> The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. <sup>2</sup> He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. <sup>3</sup> He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. <sup>4</sup> Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. <sup>5</sup> You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. <sup>6</sup> Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

#### WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE LED?

What does it mean to be led by God?

# HIS HOLY NAME What has the LORD done that brings honor where I caused dishonor? YOU CAN PRAY WITH US... 1. Worship the LORD for His good and wise leadership. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit that He goes first in all ways - in loving us, providing for us, redeeming us and in daily guiding us in His good design. 2. How have you lived as if God's leadership is foolish or wrong? Confess your pride and unbelief to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and change your defiant heart to be truly trusting and loyal. 3. Give thanks to Jesus for His work to redeem us rather than abandoning us as He justly could. Thank Him for identifying with you, bearing your guilt by His death, and restoring you to wholeness by His resurrection power. 4. Who do you know that is suspicious of God's leading? Pray for them, asking the Lord to make known to them His wise, shepherding care. 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you the fruit of faithfulness. Jesus' loyalty implanted in you is good news! So ask for the Spirit to help you live faithfully following the Father's leadership.

AND LED WHERE, TO WHAT?
