3. Jesus loves even His enemies and died so they could have the opportunity to turn to Him for forgiveness and hope. How does knowing this impact my view of those around me that disregard Jesus? The church? Me?

4. As a follower of Jesus, I am commissioned to do as He did. In light of that, what can I begin to do this week to make 1 Corinthians 9:22-23 a reality in my life?

Jesus willingly sacrificed His life on a rescue mission for our sake.

¹³ For he has rescued us from the kingdom of darkness and transferred us into the Kingdom of his dear Son, ¹⁴ who purchased our freedom and forgave our sins.

Colossians 1:13-14 (NLT)

Jesus wasn't a victim. He knew up front that His mission would cost His life.

For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many.

Mark 10:45 (NLT)

For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God.

1 Peter 3:18 (NIV)

Jesus didn't come just for those who were "good" or trying hard. He came to rescue all people - even His enemies!

⁶ When we were utterly helpless, Christ came at just the right time and died for us sinners. ⁷ Now, most people would not be willing to die for an upright person, though someone might perhaps be willing to die for a person who is especially good. ⁸ But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.
