Why do many who claim to be followers of Jesus not seem to have the joy, peace, fulfillment, and hope that reflects Jesus? The answer is found in the two stories of Jesus we looked at today. Unless a person is fully devoted to Christ, they will not receive the benefits of a relationship with Him. Jesus made it clear that a person cannot be committed to more than one leader of their life (Luke 16:13).

Let's all take some time to honestly assess where we are in our devotion to Jesus and think about how we can strengthen our "follow-ship". A prayer that is great for starting this assessment is...

<sup>23</sup> Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts.
 <sup>24</sup> Point out anything in me that offends you, and lead me along the path of everlasting life.

God, how does my use/view of money reflect devotion to you? My earning, giving, spending, and investing?

God, how does my use/view of time reflect devotion to you? Are you pleased with how I invest in my time alone with you, my church, my family, hobbies, and health habits?

God, how do my relationships with others reflect devotion to you?

God, how does my use of my talents and abilities reflect devotion to you?

God, how does my internal thought life reflect devotion to you?
