Do I see others as my equals? Or do I regularly compare myself to others in hopes of coming out on top?

How courageous am I?

When was the last time I did something that required faith and courage? What was it?

Is there something I know God wants me to do or say that I am fearful of considering? What is it? If I were to walk in courage, what would a step of faith look like?

OUTREACH PROJECTS UPDATES



The "UnderAware about Underwear" drive resulted in over 477 socks, t-shirts, and underwear being collected for the Central Union Mission in DC, whose mission works to help transform the area's toughest rehabilitation cases and the chronically homeless into productive members of society.





Starting Point is a conversational environment where people can explore faith and experience community. Starting Point groups are safe places for people with questions about faith, as well as those who want to learn about the Bible and Christianity. Groups meet for nine weeks to explore the grand story of the Bible.

You may have questions that you've always wondered about but never felt you could ask at church, legitimate questions that would make many Christians uncomfortable. Ask them. Nothing is off-limits. We want to have conversations about the stuff that really matters to you—even when it's difficult to talk about—especially when it's difficult to talk about.

Starting Point is designed for:

- SEEKERS: those who are curious about God, Jesus, the Bible, or Christianity
- STARTERS: those who have just begun a relationship with Jesus Christ
- RETURNERS: those who have some church experience, but have been away for a while


The group will begin on Saturday, September 15th and end on Saturday, November 10th. This group meets at New Hope during the Saturday 5:30 pm service.
