What's Mercy?

- Grace = <u>forgiveness</u> for the <u>guilty</u>.
- Mercy = <u>Compassion</u> for their misery.

...he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy...

Titus 3:5a (NIV)

How can I be merciful?

- I can <u>include</u> those who are different.
- I can <u>restore</u> those who've <u>done</u> wrong.

- I can <u>support</u> those who are <u>discouraged</u>.
- I can <u>serve</u> those who are <u>disadvantaged</u>.
- I can <u>endure</u> those who are <u>difficult</u>.
- I can love those who disagree.

Why focus on giving mercy?

- Because we've received it.
 - It <u>proves</u> our <u>relationship</u> with God.
 - It <u>protects</u> our <u>fellowship</u> with God.
- · Because other people need it.

<u>Pure</u> = <u>free</u> from pollution, mixture or foreign elements

<u>Heart</u> = <u>command and control center</u> <u>that governs</u> our thoughts, feelings and actions

How to Develop a Pure Heart:

- Purity is <u>motivated</u> by <u>pleasing</u> God.
- Purity is <u>protected</u> by <u>obeying</u> God.
- Purity is <u>powered</u> by the <u>Spirit of</u> God.
- Purity is <u>restored</u> by <u>honesty toward</u> God.


