Series: He Will Be Our Peace

Message: Peace Treaty Speaker: Rusty Coram

Date: December 22/23, 2018

God takes our relationships with others seriously. Of course, we can't make someone else choose to reconcile, but he expects us to faithfully do our part to try. This week, we had the Lord's Supper (communion) as part of our service. This is not merely a ceremony, but an act of worship and remembrance for what God did in forgiving us. The following is written to the church in Corinth, where relationships were not being handled the way God intended. (The pattern there was to eat a meal and then have the Lord's Supper.) As you read, ask God to speak to you about your relationships...and really listen!

<sup>17</sup> But in the following instructions, I cannot praise you. For it sounds as if more harm than good is done when you meet together. <sup>18</sup> First, I hear that there are divisions among you when you meet as a church, and to some extent I believe it. <sup>19</sup> But, of course, there must be divisions among you so that you who have God's approval will be recognized! <sup>20</sup> When you meet together, you are not really interested in the Lord's Supper. <sup>21</sup> For some of you hurry to eat your own meal without sharing with others. As a result, some go hungry while others get drunk. <sup>22</sup> What? Don't you have your own homes for eating and drinking? Or do

you really want to disgrace God's church and shame the poor? What am I supposed to say? Do you want me to praise you? Well, I certainly will not praise you for this! 23 For I pass on to you what I received from the Lord himself. On the night when he was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took some bread <sup>24</sup> and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and said, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this to remember me." 25 In the same way, he took the cup of wine after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant between God and his people—an agreement confirmed with my blood. Do this to remember me as often as you drink it." <sup>26</sup> For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are announcing the Lord's death until he comes again. <sup>27</sup> So anyone who eats this bread or drinks this cup of the Lord unworthily is guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. <sup>28</sup> That is why you should examine yourself before eating the bread and drinking the cup. <sup>29</sup> For if you eat the bread or drink the cup without honoring the body of Christ, you are eating and drinking God's judgment upon yourself. 30 That is why many of you are weak and sick and some have even died. 31 But if we would examine ourselves, we would not be judged by God in this way.

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<sup>14</sup> Work at living in peace with everyone, and work at living a holy life, for those who are not holy will not see the Lord. <sup>15</sup> Look after each other so that none of you fails to receive the grace of God. Watch out that no poisonous root of bitterness grows up to trouble you, corrupting many.

<sup>21</sup> You have heard that our ancestors were told, 'You must not murder. If you commit murder, you are subject to judgment.' <sup>22</sup> But I say, if you are even angry with someone, you are subject to judgment! If you call someone an idiot, you are in danger of being brought before the court. And if you curse someone, you are in danger of the fires of hell. <sup>23</sup> So if you are presenting a sacrifice at the altar in the Temple and you suddenly remember that someone has something against you, <sup>24</sup> leave your sacrifice there at the altar. Go and be reconciled to that person. Then come and offer your sacrifice to God.

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



#### Welcome to the 2019 Bible Reading Plan!

This year we are going to read through the New Testament chronologically, meaning that we will read the events in the order they are believed to have occurred. We are going to be following the Navigator's 5 x 5 x 5 plan again this year. This plan will have each of us reading a chapter a day through specific books of the Bible, which will take approximately five minutes. We will read for five out of seven days each week and will have the option of using two days to dig deeper or reflect on what we've read. Just spending a few minutes each day in God's Word is not only doable, but has the power to be life changing! We hope you will join us in this challenge and watch what God does in your heart and life this year.



As a result of funds collected during our 2018 Walk 4 Water, Water 4 Kids International was able to open a well on November 3rd in Shangu, Uganda. Thanks for bringing clean, life-saving water to the precious people of Shangu and their surrounding communities. Having clean water is now something that hundreds do not need to think about. In partnership with The Back Pack and Silo Center Preschool, nearly 600 coats were collected this year. During the four-week collection, the Fairfax County Public School Homeless Liaison Office would pick up the coats after each weekend. The need in our community is so great they were able to place EACH coat to those in need in the community within days of picking them up. Having a warm coat is now something that nearly 600 individuals do not need to think about. Thanks!





The Holiday of Hope initiative provided four gifts each, for 76 children, from five elementary schools in our area. The initiative also helped three families that are homeless and 25 teens that are homeless or in an unaccompanied minor situation (living in a shelter, with another family, etc.). In addition to that, gifts were provided for the Last Chance Boutique that allowed county social workers to help fill needs and wish lists for additional students in the Fairfax County School system.
