



Walking in Christ's footsteps means checking your <u>heart daily</u>.

You adulterers! Don't you realize that friendship with the world makes you an enemy of God? I say it again: If you want to be a friend of the world, you make yourself an enemy of God. James 4:4 (NLT)

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.

Matthew 6:33 (NLT)

Walking in Christ's footsteps means <u>not</u> being friends with the world.

...God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.

James 4:6 (NLT)

The <u>proud</u> are those who turn their hearts away from God. The <u>humble</u> understand and practice total dependence on God.
