

After reviewing the message notes, consider the following questions. These would be good for a discussion with a friend, family member and/or Small Group.

In the message, we looked at the similarity between a computer operating system (OS) and how each of us processes and makes decisions.

How careful are you with your computer devices to make sure the OS doesn't get corrupted or a virus?

What do you do to ensure your devices are "safe"?

Have you ever been infected with a computer virus or malware?

If so, what problems did it cause?

What did you do to remedy the situation?

Now consider your life being directed by beliefs, values, attitudes and principles - the operating system that guides you. How was your life OS programmed? Are you careful to make sure that bugs, viruses and malware don't infect you?

Are you careful to vet your beliefs, values, attitudes and principles with what the Bible clearly teaches? If not, why?

God makes it clear that His followers need to regularly learn what the Bible teaches, adopt His wisdom, and adjust any thinking that is different to be in line with His. If we do, we will be blessed. If we don't, we will make a mess of our life and other's.


What will you do this week to continue/begin to make sure you are growing in wisdom?

There is a path before each person that seems right, but it ends in death.

Proverbs 14:12 (NLT)

There are big differences between $\underline{\text{cool}}$, $\underline{\text{smart}}$, $\underline{\text{foolish}}$ and $\underline{\text{wise}}$.

¹³ If you are wise and understand God's ways, prove it by living an honorable life, doing good works with the humility that comes from wisdom. ¹⁴ But if you are bitterly jealous and there is selfish ambition in your heart, don't cover up the truth with boasting and lying. 15 For jealousy and selfishness are not God's kind of wisdom. Such things are earthly, unspiritual, and demonic. 16 For wherever there is jealousy and selfish ambition, there you will find disorder and evil of every kind. 17 But the wisdom from above is first of all pure. It is also peace loving, gentle at all times, and willing to vield to others. It is full of mercy and good deeds. It shows no favoritism and is always sincere. ¹⁸ And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness.

HOW TO BECOME WISE

Learn what is wise.

¹⁹ Understand this, my dear brothers and sisters: You must all be quick to listen, slow to speak, and

slow to get angry. ²⁰ Human anger does not produce the righteousness God desires. ²¹ So get rid of all the filth and evil in your lives, and humbly accept the word God has planted in your hearts, for it has the power to save your souls.

¹⁶ All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. ¹⁷ God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.

Practice what you learn.

²² But don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. Joshua 1:8 (NLT)


Learn with and from others that also want to be wise.


James 5:18-20 (NLT)



This month, we have been focusing on sharing our faith by giving the gift of love and hope to those in need. We have two partners we work with to help our neighbors around the world. They are Hope 4 Kids International (hope4kidsinternational.org) and Feed My Starving Children (fmsc.org). Both of these amazing organizations are focused on helping children around the world have a better tomorrow. We are committed to meeting the needs of 50 children through H4Kl and providing meals that will feed 1,644 children this year through FMSC. Will you join us?

Sponsoring a child through H4KI costs just \$1 a day. For \$31 a month you can provide for basic needs, healthcare, educational tuition, cost of supplies and books. You will receive a picture and biographical information about the child you sponsor and have the opportunity to correspond with them. We have made it super simple for you to see the kids in need of sponsorship. Visit newhope.org/givethegift to view the children and their profiles. You can also stop by the table in the front lobby to see the kids available for sponsorship.

Feeding a child for an entire year through FMSC costs just \$.24 a day or \$88 for the year. When we supply the food, ministry partners who work with these children are able to use their resources for education, medical and housing needs. The food is sent to the area of greatest need and although you won't see specific faces, once our food has shipped following our mobilepack in November, we will let you know the food's destination. **Visit give.classy.org/hopeforhelp to make a donation for the much-needed food through feed my starving children.**
