When it comes to <u>relationships</u>, those who follow Jesus have a very <u>clear standard</u> to <u>live</u> up to.

<sup>17</sup> Never pay back evil with more evil. Do things in such a way that everyone can see you are honorable. <sup>18</sup> <u>Do all that you can to live in peace</u> <u>with everyone</u>. <sup>19</sup> Dear friends, never take revenge. Leave that to the righteous anger of God. For the Scriptures say, "I will take revenge; I will pay them back says the LORD."

Romans 12:17-19 (NLT)

## How we use our words really matters.

There is one who speaks rashly like the thrusts of a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing. Proverbs 12:18 (NASB)

Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them. Ephesians 4:29 (NLT)

One of the most important things we can do is to seek reconciliation when we have wronged someone – <u>God, another person, or both</u>.

The first statement in our series: "I was wrong, please forgive me."

The second statement: "<u>Is there anything you</u> <u>need</u>?"

To live this out will require resisting the incessant pull of "WAM?". (What About Me?)

 <sup>3</sup> Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. <sup>4</sup> Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too.
<sup>5</sup> You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had.

#### Followers of Jesus can relate this way because we have <u>God and His promises</u> as our foundation.

The Lord is my shepherd; I have all that I need. Psalm 23:1 (NLT)

And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:19 (NLT)

<sup>9</sup> Fear the Lord, you his godly people, for those who fear him will have all they need. <sup>10</sup> Even strong young lions sometimes go hungry, but those who trust in the Lord will lack no good thing. Psalm 34:9–10 (NLT)

## For anyone aspiring to leadership...

 <sup>11</sup> The greatest among you must be a servant.
<sup>12</sup> But those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted. Matthew 23:11–12 (NLT)

# We should not limit our asking *"Is there anything you need?"* only to those who will <u>reciprocate</u> or <u>appreciate</u> it.

<sup>20</sup> If your enemies are hungry, feed them. If they are thirsty, give them something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals of shame on their heads. <sup>21</sup> Don't let evil conquer you, but conquer evil by doing good.
