Series: I Declare War Message: Actions Speak Speaker: Rusty Coram

Date: January 19/20, 2019

As Jesus was gaining in influence and popularity, His critics and enemies were doing all they could to try to discredit or embarrass Him. Below is an instance when one of these critics tried to get Jesus to make a public gaffe by getting Him to say things that could be used against Him. This critic was hoping Jesus would leave something essential out and therefore, give fuel to accusing Him of heresy. Instead, Jesus gives an answer that summarizes all the teaching of the Bible clearly and compellingly.

<sup>35</sup> One of them, an expert in religious law, tried to trap him with this question: <sup>36</sup> "Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the law of Moses?" <sup>37</sup> Jesus replied, "'You must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind. <sup>38</sup> This is the first and greatest commandment. <sup>39</sup> A second is equally important: Love your neighbor as yourself. <sup>40</sup> The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments."

Matthew 22:35-40 (NLT)

You and I can use this as a filter for evaluating our thoughts, words and actions - "Does this lead me to better love God and others?"

Today we are focusing on our actions, and we wrote down some that we believe God wants us to adopt and some we need to consider changing. The following passage reminds us of the reason why we do this.

13 So think clearly and exercise self-control. Look forward to the gracious salvation that will come to you when Jesus Christ is revealed to the world.
14 So you must live as God's obedient children.
Don't slip back into your old ways of living to satisfy your own desires. You didn't know any better then. 15 But now you must be holy in everything you do, just as God who chose you is holy. 16 For the Scriptures say, "You must be holy because I am holy."

1 Peter 1:13-16 (NLT)

The word "holy" means something set apart for special use. The idea is that those of us that have accepted Jesus as our Savior and Leader are "set apart" for His purposes and we no longer do things merely because we want to – we want to do what He wants us to do.

Look over the things you considered that you should change or adopt and make sure they are things you believe God would be pleased with. Going to Him in prayer and asking for help is the first step in implementing them. And hang on, next week at the conclusion of the series, we will look at what God provides to make real change possible.

Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

**Starting Point** is a conversational environment where people can explore faith and experience community. Starting Point groups are safe places for people with questions about faith, as well as those who want to learn about the Bible and Christianity.
