In Ephesians 5 we read...

The 10 commandments were given so we can...

...know what God is like.

...know how to relate to Him and others.

...know why we need a savior.

Command #2:

⁸ You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind, or an image of anything in the heavens or on the earth or in the sea. ⁹ You must not bow down to them or worship them, for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God who will not tolerate your affection for any other gods.

Deuteronomy 5:8-9a (NLT)

Idol worship is not merely something <u>from</u> the ancient past.

An idol is anything that <u>takes the rightful</u> <u>place of God</u> in my life. (See Mark 10:17-31)

Whatever has my <u>primary attention</u> is my God.

⁵ You can be sure that no immoral, impure, or greedy person will inherit the Kingdom of Christ and of God. For a greedy person is an idolater, worshiping the things of this world. ⁶ Don't be fooled by those who try to excuse these sins...

Ephesians 5:5–6 (NLT)

So put to death the sinful, earthly things lurking within you. Have nothing to do with sexual immorality, impurity, lust, and evil desires. Don't be greedy, for a greedy person is an idolater, worshiping the things of this world.

Colossians 3:5 (NLT)

greed (pleonexia): to have + more

God is not willing to share our <u>affection</u>. His jealousy is a result <u>of His love for us</u>.

⁸ And now the word of the Lord is ringing out from you to people everywhere, even beyond Macedonia and Achaia, for wherever we go we find people telling us about your faith in God. We don't need to tell them about it, ⁹ for they keep talking about the wonderful welcome you gave us and how you turned away from idols to serve the living and true God.
